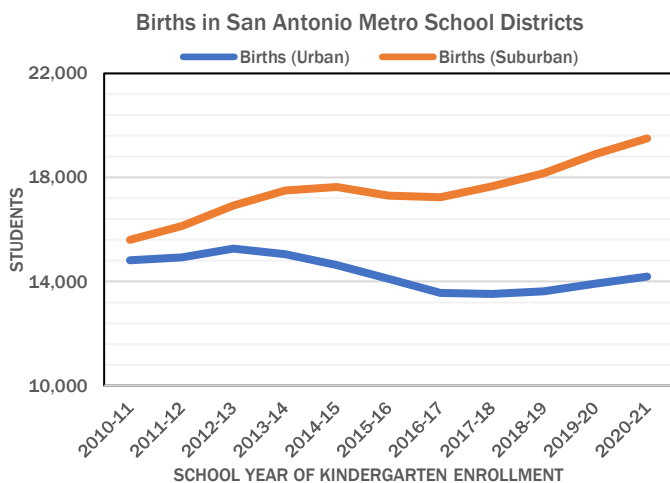
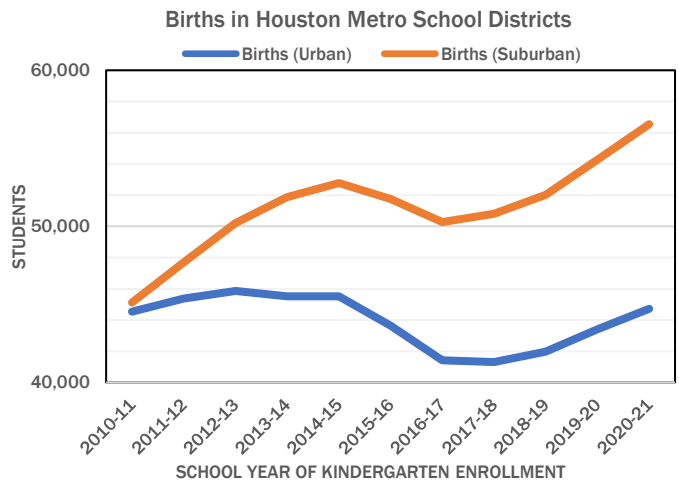
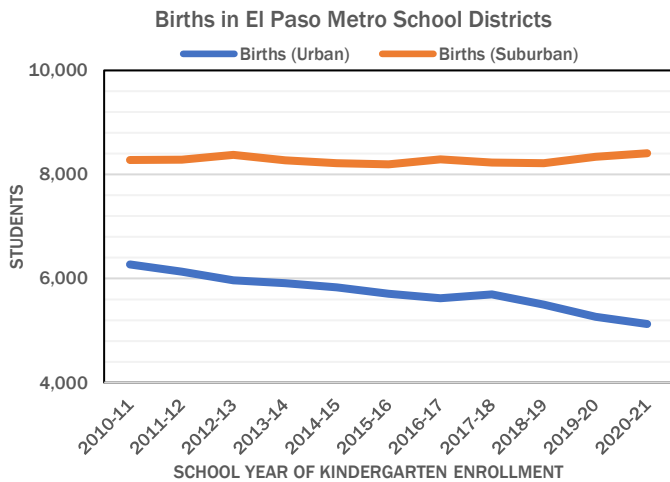
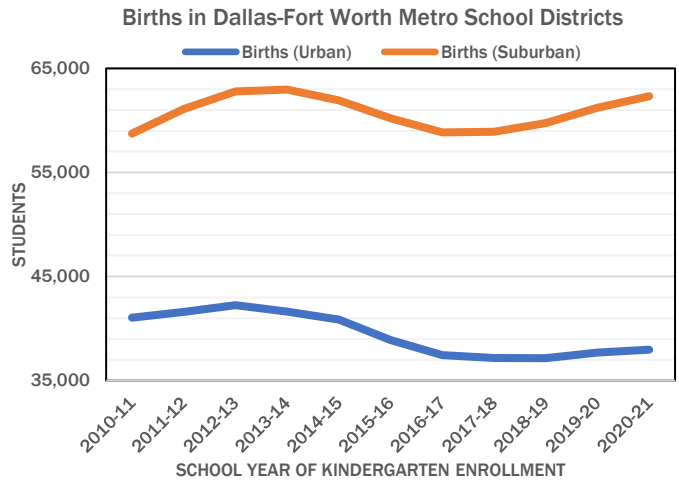
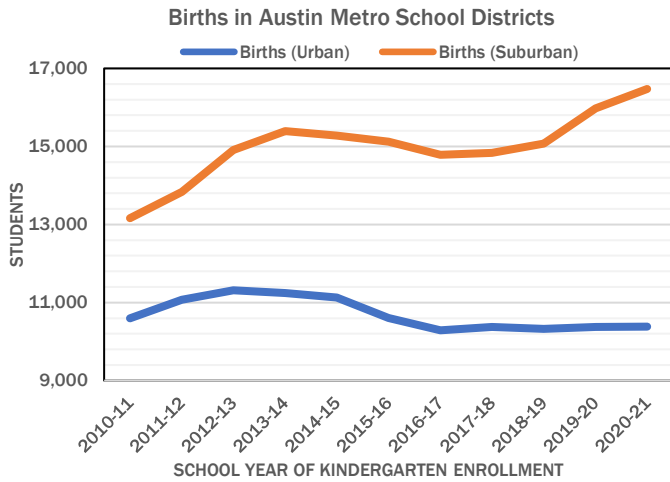


Live Births by Metropolitan Statistical Area
